## Scholarships for Prospective Students

---

**Davenport Leadership Scholarships** are \$7,000 renewable awards based on academic merit. The application for this scholarship consists of two stages. This scholarship does not require financial aid (as determined by FAFSA), but is open to U.S. Citizens or permanent residents only.

- **Stage 1:** A brief on-line survey must be submitted between early December and late January. Survey asks for information about Extracurricular Activities, Leadership positions, and Honors and Awards, Employment (paid or volunteer), and current high school GPA (as reported in last grade report), and current email address.
- **Stage 2 (By invitation only):** Full application. Following review of initial surveys, candidates will be invited to submit a full application due by mid/late February.

**Pratt Scholarships** have no application process. Students will be selected for these one-time \$5,000 awards on the basis of being a first generation college student (i.e. no parent has received a 4-year college degree), and on superior academic credentials. Recipients of these awards will be notified by late March. This scholarship does not require financial need (as determined by FAFSA). International students will be considered for this scholarship.

**All other freshmen scholarships** have no application process. Students will be considered for remaining scholarships based upon admission to the College of Engineering as an entering freshman student in General Engineering. Announcements of these awards will be made by late March.
